We are excited to announce that the Single Subject Credential Program at Stan State will begin offering an intern pathway in Fall 2021! This is an opportunity to work in your own classroom while completing your credential.

To be eligible for the intern pathway, you must have:

- 1. job offer
- 2. CPR Certification
- 3. passed CBEST
- 4. passed CSETs or have completed a subject matter prep program
- 5. taken the following courses prior to Fall 2021:
 - a. EDSS 4110 or EDUC 4400
 - b. EDSS 4115 or EDSS 4215
 - c. EDSS 4550
 - d. PSYCH 324
 - e. EDSE 4310
 - f. KINS 4165
 - g. EDIT 4170

This is <u>NOT</u> a decision to make lightly. Teaching full-time while finishing course work and TPAs is a daunting undertaking. The successful candidate for this pathway should be:

- highly motivated
- organized
- possess a strong work ethic
- be coachable
- committed to students
- reflective

In addition, selecting this route means a continued commitment to the coursework of our program. You cannot successfully earn your credential unless you have been successful in the courses.
