Policy on Course Deletion (14/AS/80/EPC)

Regular catalog courses may be deactivated in one of two fashions:

- 1. A department/division or program committee may request that a course be deactivated. Such a deactivation will take effect upon approval of the Office of the Provost/Vice President for Academic Affairs. When deactivated, the course will be removed from the University catalog.
- 2. Courses will be deactivated and removed from the catalog if they are not offered for three consecutive years. Department/divisions or program committees may appeal to the Office of the Provost/Vice President for Academic Affairs for a one-year extension for extenuating circumstances. If a course is not taught in the fourth year, it shall be deactivated.
