To reduce the spread of COVID-19, before you enter you must confirm that you are free from the following symptoms:

New and/or unexplained symptoms of COVID-19:

- Fever of 100.4 degrees F or higher
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches

- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

### ADDITIONALLY, YOU SELF-ATTEST THAT:

- You have not tested positive for COVID-19 within the last 10 days. If you tested positive with COVID-19 in the last 10 days, you attest that you are asymptomatic or symptoms are resolving, you've been fever-free for 24 hours without use of fever-reducing medications, you have tested NEGATIVE on Day 5 or later, and you MUST WEAR A FACE COVERING around others.
- You have not been exposed to a person infected with COVID-19, or if you have been exposed within the last 10 days you are strongly encouraged to wear a face covering.
