## STAN STATE STEM AMBASSADORS: SEPTEMBER 2016 TO JUNE 2017

-32 Stan State STEM Ambassadors worked on programs such as Science Saturday (4), Stan State Junior Scientist (4), Cunningham Science Fair, Migrant Winter Prep, National Ag Science Center and Science Day.
-The STEM Ambassadors volunteered approximately 380 hours working with K-12 students and 110 hours for trainings and meetings.

- 227 students from the College of Science volunteered approximately 908 hours working during Science Day.
- 21 Chemistry students and 9 students from the College of Education volunteered a total of 192 hours working with K-12 students. 12 Physics students volunteered a total of 96 hours.
- In total, 301 Stan State students contributed more than 1,686 volunteer hours serving our community.

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## K-12 COMMUNITY: SEPTEMBER 2016 TO JUNE 2017

- Stan State STEM Ambassadors have served K-12 students from 20 schools in our community.
- Stan State hosted 411 K-12 students at the Naraghi Hall of Science for Science Day, Junior Scientist, Delhi Academy, and Migrant Winter Prep and worked with approximately 450 K-12 students at their schools.
- Science Day served approximately 1500 members of our community who included K-12 regional students and their families.
- A total of 861 K-12 students have received services in STEM related fields due to the Stan State STEM Ambassadors Program. Participants received $\mathbf{1 1 7 0 0}$ hours of free STEM related activities.
