- The remaining prerequisite courses must be in progress or planned to be completed with a grade of C or better by the time the program starts.
- All non-science prerequisites and Chemistry need to be a minimum of 3 units. All other prerequisites need to be a minimum of 4 units.
- Only the first science and first non-science prerequisite retake are allowed. Additional retakes will disqualify your application
- One course may be taken in the Summer to complete the prerequisite requirements prior to Fall entry.
- AP courses are accepted if the minimum score is met and accepted by the University.

How to Apply

Fall Entry Application

October 1st – January 15th

Spring Entry Application

August 1st – August 31st

- Apply to the University and our program by the Cal State Apply deadline at calstate.edu/apply
- Current Stan State students can submit their applications at csustan.edu/nursing
- Program admission is contingent upon meeting the minimum requirements listed below and passing a physical exam, drug screening, and a background check.

Minimum Requirements

- Overall GPA of 3.0.
- Science prerequisite GPA of 3.0 {Grade of C or better in each prerequisite course}.
- Non-Science prerequisite GPA of 3.0 {Grade of C or better in each prerequisite course}.
- At least 2 non-science prerequisites must be completed at the time of application.
- At least 2 science prerequisite courses must be completed at the time of application.
- All prerequisite courses must be taken for a letter grade (No pass/fail or credit/no credit).
 - Prerequisites taken in Spring 2020 only can be pass/fail or credit/no credit.
- Minimum test score (Total Score) of 70% on the ATI TEAS Version 7.
- **Only TEAS Version 7 will be accepted starting August 1, 2023 (Spring 2024 applications).**
