Primary APR Review Criteria

- Significant changes since last program review (evidence of progress in support of implementation plan priorities)
- Strength of the new implementation plan; evidence-based documentation in support of implementation plan priorities; sound plans for program maintenance/development
- Commitment to student learning objectives appropriate for the program / direct assessment measures and analysis / evidence of student progress and success in completing the major
- Curriculum and instruction / program structure / program delivery & scheduling for timely student progress through the major
- Enrollment trends: # of majors; enrollments in required, elective and prerequisite courses; recruitment objectives/plans to address enrollment issues/graduation rates for the major
- Program advising practices; mentoring, early warning systems and other support structures to help promote student success
- Faculty research, scholarship and creative activity; program support for scholarship
- Faculty expertise to provide quality instruction in support of effective program breadth, depth and delivery
- Effective delivery and assessment of GE/service courses
- Recommendation re: program continuation, modification, and specific points addressing the implementation plan
