ADMISSION INFORMATION

Minimum requirements for admission to the LVN program:

1. Must be a high school (or higher) graduate with a grade point average of 2.0 or higher, or the equivalent as measured by the General Education development (G.E. D.) Test or by the California State High School Proficiency examination. Applicants with high school grade point averages below 2.0 must have completed 15 units of college-level work with a grade point average of 2.0 higher.
2. Must be in good health.
3. Must have completed within five years of the date of application the following courses as indicated above, or their equivalent with a grade of "C" or better: BIOL -16 OR 50, NUTR -10, ALLH -67, AND VOEN -46A.
