The Capacity and Preparatory Review (CPR) report for reaffirmation of accreditation by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) is available for review at the Self Study Website, http://web.csustan.edu/WASC/Pages/CapacityPreparatoryReview.html

This report will constitute the second of three reports in this process; the final draft must be submitted in June 2008. This draft has been prepared from work completed by the four Inquiry Circles and extensive campus participation. Input from an earlier draft, available online since September, has been incorporated as appropriate. Specific recommendations made by the Inquiry Circles are available on the individual Inquiry Circle websites.

In order to make our WASC deadline, a finalized text must be completed by the end of March 2008. To address any unresolved issues, we thus ask that all campus feedback be submitted to the team by Friday, March 7, 2008. The draft will be discussed in Open Forum of Academic Senate during the February 26, 2008 meeting.

To facilitate campus review of this CPR report draft, the Self-Study Team has distributed hard copies of the draft to members of the President's Executive Cabinet, Academic Affairs Council, Senate Executive Committee, Student Affairs Council, Executive Council of Associated Students, Inc., chairs, liaisons and staff support of the four Inquiry Circles, and to the chairs of URPTC, LAC, RSCAPC, and the four UEPC subcommittees.
