  - A. **AB 2881 Priority Registration for Student Parents.** The chancellor's office is not providing guidance on this mandate. There is no verification process. UEPC needs to draft a resolution for first reading at Academic Senate. It will be effective during fall 2023 and available for spring 2024 registration. The process should be similar to priority registration for student athletes. It should be a class level priority. UEPC unanimously approved the resolution to move it forward as first reading at Academic Senate on February 14, 2023.
  
  - B. **Ad Hoc Committee on the Multicultural Requirement- Final Recommendation.** The feedback from open forums was used to revise the course learning outcomes (CLOs) and title for the requirement. The General Education Subcommittee needs clear guidance on how to review and approve courses. UEPC unanimously approved the resolution to move it forward as first reading at Academic Senate on February 14, 2023.
  
  - C. **Grade Appeal Policy.** Wooley is working on revising this policy and will share the final version in the next meeting.
