Other Student Eligibility Information:

- Students are not eligible to receive CalFresh if they receive a meal plan that provides 50% or more of their meals.
- Student Financial Aid and most educational income is not counted as income for CalFresh.
- Students under age 22 living with their parent(s) must apply with their parent(s) as a household.
- Students under the age of 22 living on their own may be eligible for CalFresh benefits.
- Students must also have an eligible immigration status (cannot be DACA, Student Visa, or Dream Act)
- The primary applicant must provide identification (picture ID)
