• Students are not eligible to receive CalFresh if they receive a meal plan that provides 50% or more of their meals.
 Student Financial Aid and most educational income is <u>not</u> counted as income for CalFresh.
 Students under age 22 living with their parent(s) must apply with their parent(s) as a household. Students under the age of 22 living on their gum may be clivible for ColErect honofits.
 Students under the age of 22 living on their own may be eligible for CalFresh benefits. Students must also have an eligible immigration status (cannot be DACA, Student Visa, or Dream Act)
 The primary applicant must provide identification (picture ID)
