***If Lower Division General Education and/or Major Prerequisite courses have not been completed prior to transfer, additional classes and/or semesters may be required outside of the 2-year roadmap.** Elective units may be needed to meet the required 120 semester units for a Baccalaureate Degree. Refer to the 4-year roadmap and/or University Catalog for Lower Division General Education and Major Prerequisite

The Stanislaus State General Education (GE) program is undergoing changes with the implementation of AB 1460 Ethnic Studies Graduation Requirement. In order to honor the transfer pathway of students who started prior to the new law, transfers enrolling at Stan State for the first time **fall 2021-spring 2023 will follow the 2020-21 GE Program. Major requirements will follow the 2022-23 catalog.**
