Western Undergraduate Exchange

California State University, Stanislaus is a participant in an exchange program sponsored by the Western Interstate Commission for Higher Education (WICHE) www.wiche.edu/WUE. Known as the Western Undergraduate Exchange or WUE (woo wee), students in western states may enroll in participating "out of state" four-year college programs for a reduced nonresident tuition.

Programs Available

All undergraduate majors except pre-nursing/nursing.

Eligibility and Participant requirements

New freshman and new undergraduate transfer students who are enrolling for the first time may apply for WUE. Students must request the WUE tuition rate prior to enrolling in their first term. WUE students must declare their intent to maintain their legal domicile in their home WICHE state at the time of their application.

WUE students are not eligible for California resident tuition. Students cannot apply time accrued while participating in the WUE program to establish California residency.

Students may receive the WUE tuition rate for four years or until the completion of the bachelor's degree, whichever comes first.
