CALIFORNIA STATE UNIVERSITY, STANISLAUS is seeking a professional, highly motivated, and detail-oriented individual to serve as the Campus Compliance Officer. This position reports to the Vice President of Faculty Affairs and Human Resources and, with minimal supervision, will be required to conduct research, in-person interviews, and provide legal perspectives on a broad array of complex university matters.

This position is responsible for review and/or investigation of discrimination, harassment, and other legal employment issues/complaints and, as assigned, may represent the campus at administrative hearings. This position will conduct training for the campus community on policies and regulations.

In addition, this position will be responsible for reviewing campus documents and processes to ensure compliance with federal, state, CSU system, and campus policies and regulations; collaboratively assess and develop documents and/or processes that minimize the campus liability (e.g., Institutional Review Board matters regarding human subject research projects; animal welfare projects; hazardous materials; intellectual property rights; research misconduct or conflict of interest; grant funding regulations; and campus information security practices). Serve as the campus officer/manager/coordinator for: FERPA; Whistleblower Officer; Conflict of Interest Filing; California Public Records Act requests; compliance with records retention policies.

THE UNIVERSITY: California State University, Stanislaus serves the San Joaquin Valley, one of the fastest growing areas in the country. Widely recognized for its quality academic programs, the University has 10 nationally accredited programs and approximately 400 full-time faculty.
