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How Do I Apply?

Step 1

Letter of Interest. - Interested LVNs should submit a letter of interest to the Nursing Department. If an opening occurs an invitation, an application, and instructions will be sent to those that have an interest letter on file.

Step 2

Once invited, you must then apply to the University and be admitted. Apply at www.csumentor.edu

<u>Step 3</u>

- Supplemental Nursing Application LVN to BSN applications are submitted directly to the Department of Nursing. Please note that official transcripts for prerequisite and/or general education courses taken at colleges or universities including CSU Stanislaus must accompany the application.
- \square Schedule ATI testing with the School of Nursing by calling 209-667-3141.

Minimum Requirements

- \square Overall GPA of 3.0
- Science prerequisite GPA of 2.75
- ☑ Other non-science prerequisite GPA of 2.75
- \blacksquare Grade of C or better in each prerequisite course
- No more than 2 prerequisite courses may be repeated
- Prerequisite courses must be completed before entering the program
- Complete the ATI Fundamentals and Pharmacology Exams and meet a minimum of Level II proficiency on both exams

→ Applicants will be ranked and selected according to overall GPA, science GPA, non-science GPA and ATI scores. Program admission is contingent upon passing a physical exam, drug screening and background check.
