- Send completed application with a copy of your current RN license. If you still need to take boards at the time of application, please note that on the application and send a copy of your license when you receive it.
- Send one (1) set of official transcripts from each previous attended college or university to the School of Nursing. *This is in addition* to the set of transcripts that must be sent to Enrollment Services when you applied to the university.
- Send a clinical letter*. This is a letter validating clinical competence, and is required of all applicants unless you have completed your associate degree in nursing within the last vear.

*If not currently working as an RN, the ATI Predictor exam will be used in place of the clinical letter.

Application period: March 1st through April 30th

RN to BSN students are admitted to the Fall semester only. Students wanting to begin coursework in the spring are encouraged to take any required general education courses.
