<b>Students seeking to enter the ADN-BSN program must have the following:</b>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A current license as a Registered Nurse in California.</li> <li>• Completed 60 semester units of baccalaureate-level transferable college credit.</li> <li>• Completed an AD or Diploma in nursing with a minimum of 30 semester units of nursing coursework, with a grade of C or better in each course.</li> <li>• Completed at least half of the University’s General Education breadth requirements, including (The Golden Four) college-level English Composition, Statistics, Communication/Speech, and Critical Thinking, with a grade of C or better.</li> <li>• Complete an acceptable college-level statistics course of at least 3 semester units with a grade of C or better.</li> <li>• Gained admission to the University with an overall grade point average of 2.75 or better.</li> <li>• Gained admission to the School of Nursing. Program admission is contingent upon meeting minimum requirements and passing a physical exam, drug screening and a background check.</li> </ul>		
<b>University Requirements:</b>		
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Complete University General Education requirements for the Bachelor of Science degree, (51 units minimum including transferable General Education units.)</li> <li>• Completed ADN major with 26 or 27 upper-division units.</li> <li>• Complete 9 upper-division units to meet the upper-division General Education requirements.</li> </ul>		



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<b>Additional requirements for CSU-GE's that can be taken at MJC:</b>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Area A:</b> English 103..... 3 units</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Meets CSU A.3 GE requirement</li> <li>Any course from the A.3 category will satisfy CSU GE transfer requirements; however, Stanislaus School of Nursing requires English 103.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Area B:</b> Chemistry 143..... 5units</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Meets CSU B.1 GE requirement</li> <li>If anatomy, physiology and microbiology have already been completed without college Chemistry, Chemistry 150 will suffice for a college chemistry and transfers to Stanislaus.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Area B:</b> Math 134: Statistics....4 units</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Meets CSU B.3 GE requirement</li> <li>Math 90 prerequisite</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>Area C:</b> .....6 additional units</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>3 units in C.1 <b>AND</b> C.2 categories. The transfer requirement in this category is a total of 9 units. Three units from C.1, 3 units from C.2, and 3 additional units from C. 3 <b>OR</b> another C.1 or C.2.</li> </ul>

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- Calculus AB **or** Calculus BC **or** Statistics **or**
- Completion of Math 90 or higher level Math course, or an equivalent course from another institution with a grade of C or higher.

**NOTE:** Only 70 Community College units can be transferred from any California Community College to any California State University. Additional CSU credit may be awarded for demonstrated learning, as operationalized by passing the NCLEX-RN examination.

- Send completed application with a copy of your current RN license. If you still need to take boards at the time of application, please note that on the application and send a copy of your license when you receive it.
- Send one (1) set of official transcripts from each previous attended college or university to the School of Nursing. *This is in addition* to the set of transcripts that must be sent to Enrollment Services when you applied to the university.
- Send a clinical letter\*. This is a letter validating clinical competence, and is required of all applicants unless you have completed your associate degree in nursing within the last year.

*\*If not currently working as an RN, the ATI Predictor exam will be used in place of the clinical letter.*

**Application period: March 1<sup>st</sup> through April 30<sup>th</sup>**

RN to BSN students are **admitted to the Fall semester only**. Students wanting to begin coursework in the spring are encouraged to take any required general education courses.
