Bachelor of Science in Nursing Pre-licensure Program Admission Information

<u>Prerequisites – Pre-Nursing Major</u>

At least four (4) of the prerequisites courses must be completed at the time of application to the program, two of which must be science courses and two must be non-science courses. Remaining prerequisite courses may be in progress at the time of the nursing application, and one course may be taken in the summer prior to Fall entry. Students must successfully complete all prerequisites with a minimum grade of C. All prerequisites must be completed by the time the program starts. Advanced Placement (AP) courses will be accepted if they have met the minimum required score and have been accepted by the university. See University website for more information www.csustan.edu.

Fall Entry Application Deadline Dates

<u>University Application</u> - Priority application to the university is from Oct. 1st to Nov.30th. <u>Nursing Application</u> - Application filing period for nursing is December 1st – January 15th



Spring Entry Application Deadline Dates

<u>University Application</u> -Priority application to the university is from Aug. 1st to Aug. 30th <u>Nursing Application</u> - Application filing period for nursing is the month of September

<u>Nursing Application</u> - All applicants must submit a complete Pre-licensure Nursing Program application packet. Program admission is contingent upon meeting minimum requirements listed below and passing a physical exam, drug screening and a background check.

Minimum Requirements

- ✓ Overall GPA of 3.0
- ☑ Science prerequisite GPA of 3.0 {Grade of C or better in each prerequisite course}
- ☑ Non-Science prerequisite GPA of 3.0 (Grade of C or better in each prerequisite course)
- No more than 1 science prerequisite and 1 non-science prerequisite course may be repeated.
- \square At least 2 non-science prerequisites must be completed at the time of application
- \square At least 2 science prerequisite courses must be completed at the time of application
- Minimum test score (Adjusted Individual Total Score) of 70% on the ATI TEAS V test.
