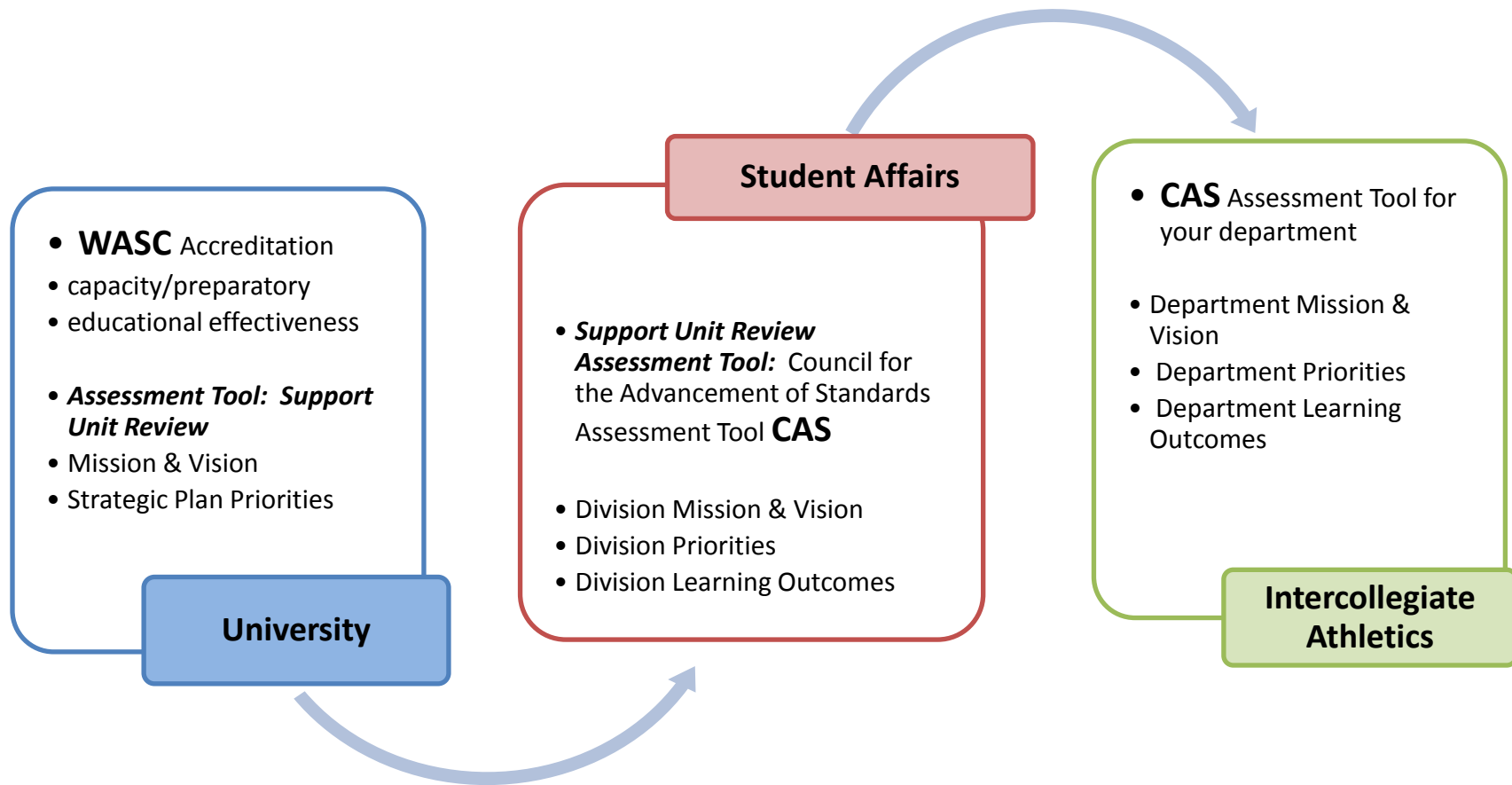
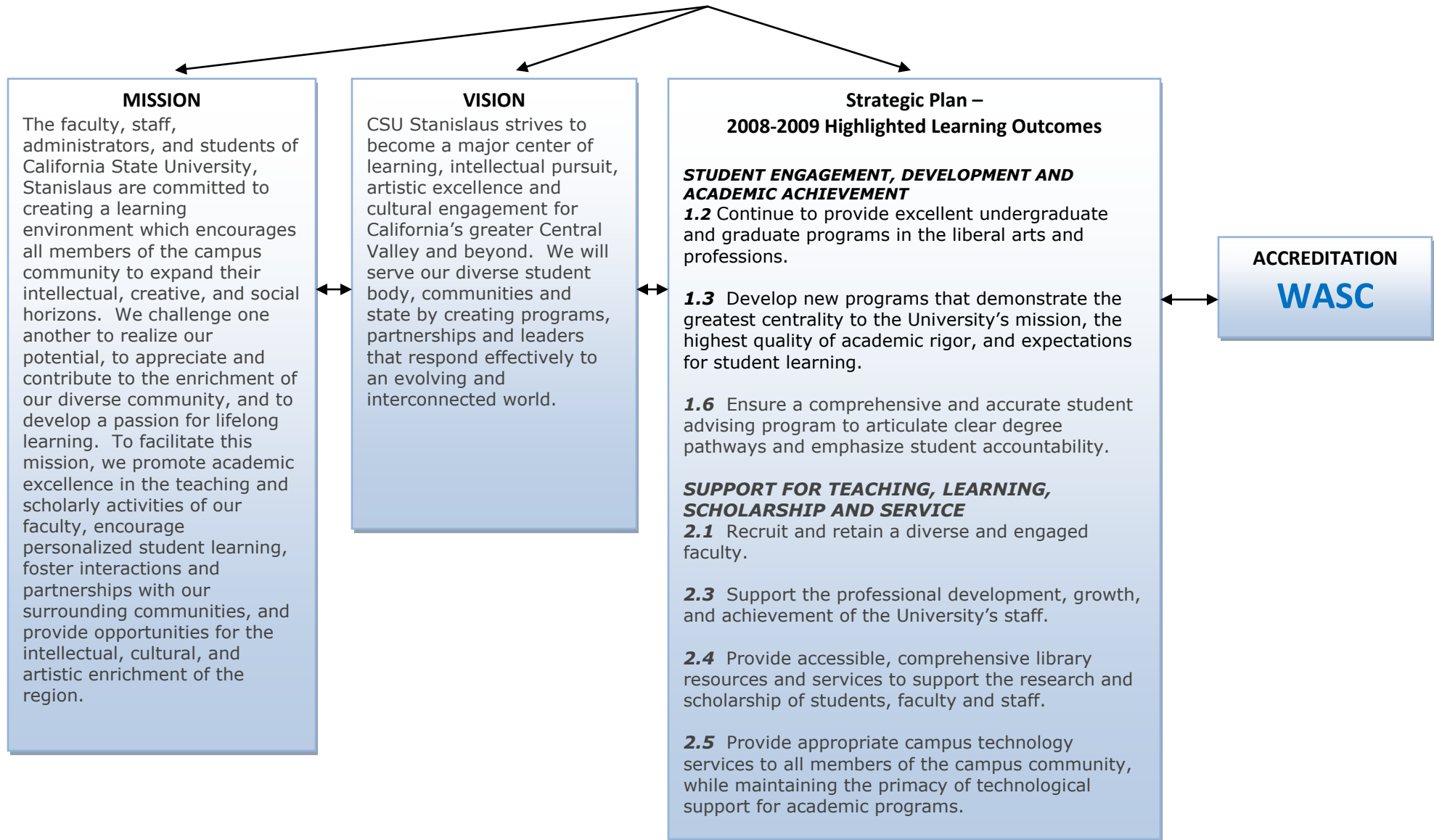


University Assessment Structure

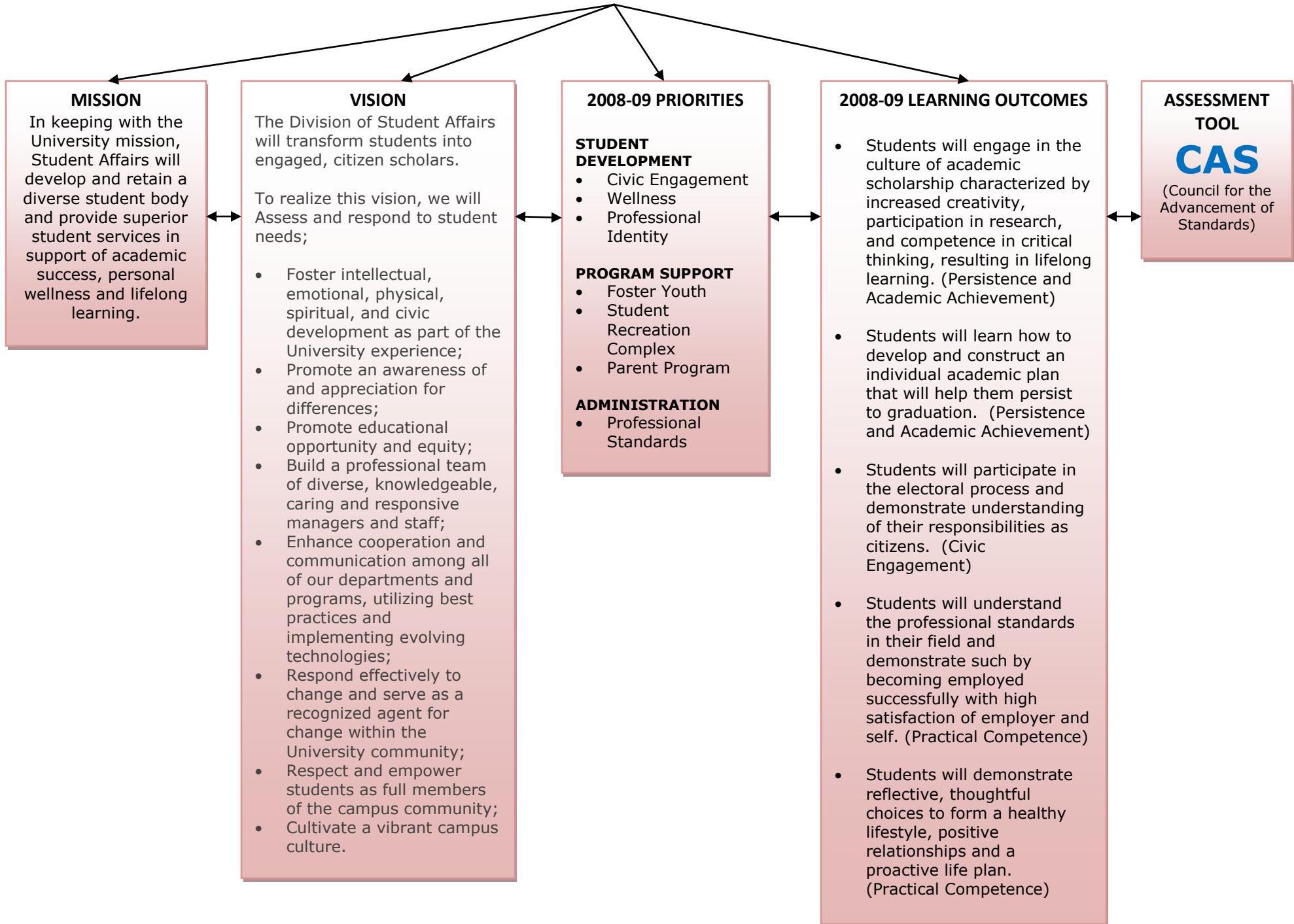
How Intercollegiate Athletics and Student Affairs Fits Into the Grand Scheme of Assessment and Accreditation



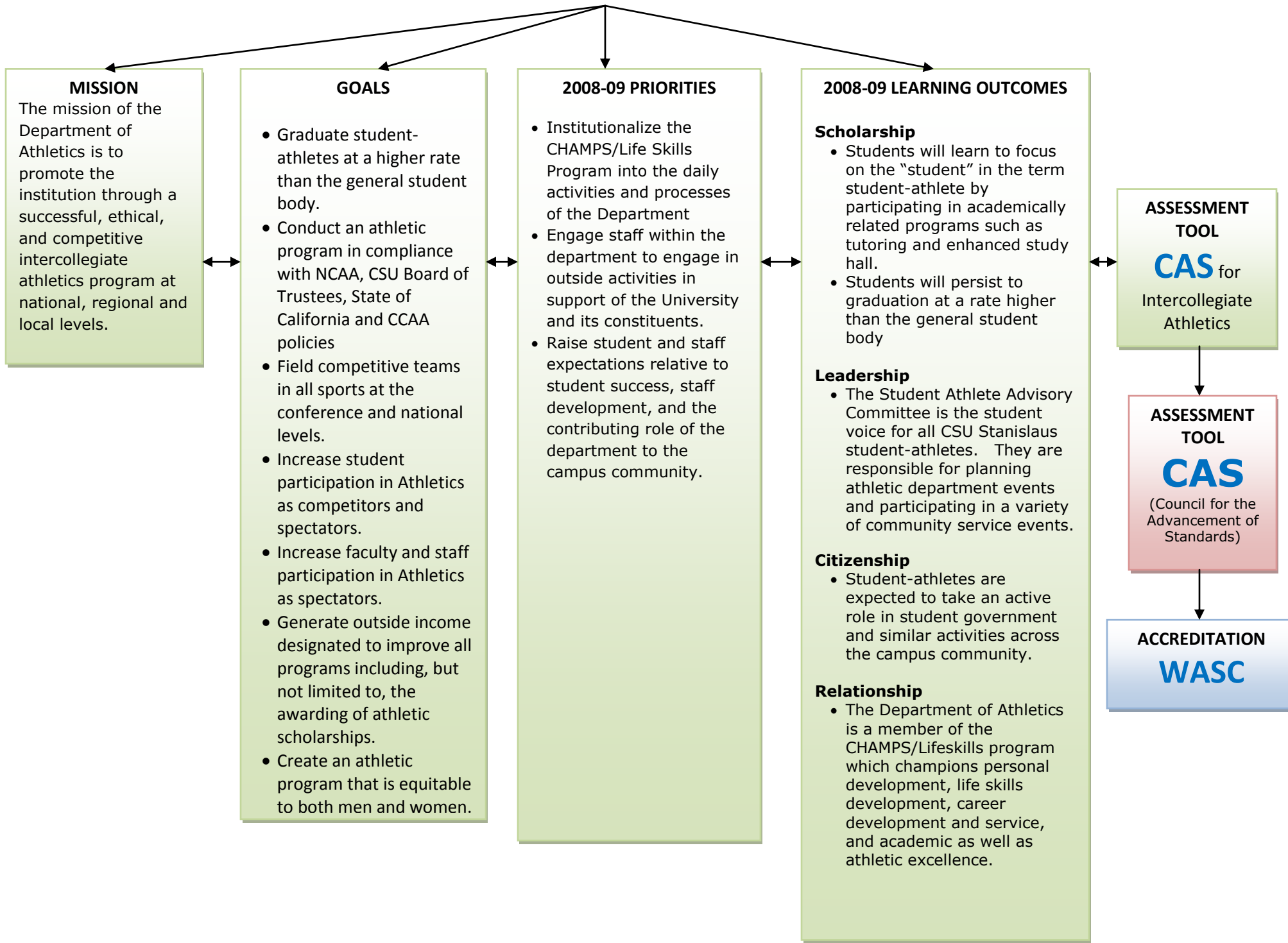

MISSION

The mission of the Department of Athletics is to promote the institution through a successful, ethical, and competitive intercollegiate athletics program at national, regional and local levels.

GOALS

- Graduate student-athletes at a higher rate than the general student body.
- Conduct an athletic program in compliance with NCAA, CSU Board of Trustees, State of California and CCAA policies
- Field competitive teams in all sports at the conference and national levels.
- Increase student participation in Athletics as competitors and spectators.
- Increase faculty and staff participation in Athletics as spectators.
- Generate outside income designated to improve all programs including, but not limited to, the awarding of athletic scholarships.
- Create an athletic program that is equitable to both men and women.

2008-09 PRIORITIES

- Institutionalize the CHAMPS/Life Skills Program into the daily activities and processes of the Department
- Engage staff within the department to engage in outside activities in support of the University and its constituents.
- Raise student and staff expectations relative to student success, staff development, and the contributing role of the department to the campus community.

2008-09 LEARNING OUTCOMES

Scholarship

- Students will learn to focus on the "student" in the term student-athlete by participating in academically related programs such as tutoring and enhanced study hall.
- Students will persist to graduation at a rate higher than the general student body

Leadership

- The Student Athlete Advisory Committee is the student voice for all CSU Stanislaus student-athletes. They are responsible for planning athletic department events and participating in a variety of community service events.

Citizenship

- Student-athletes are expected to take an active role in student government and similar activities across the campus community.

Relationship

- The Department of Athletics is a member of the CHAMPS/Lifeskills program which champions personal development, life skills development, career development and service, and academic as well as athletic excellence.
