

## University Writing Committee Annual Report 2021-2022

In the 2021-2022 academic year, the University Writing Committee made progress on several items, reviewing and approving Writing Proficiency (WP) courses, and supporting members of the committee as they drafted and proposed an alternative to GWAR. In brief, here is what we accomplished this academic year:

1. We have been working on reviews of 14 WP courses with fifteen total sections. To review the assignments and materials used by each instructor, each instructor's sections of a course are reviewed. The Committee uses Canvas for the submission process. Our thanks to those instructors who submitted complete materials in a timely fashion, as this facilitates our timely review.
