**POSITION:** The Department of Biological Sciences invites applications for a Tenure Track appointment at the level of Assistant Professor. We are seeking an organismal biologist with a strong background in vertebrate physiology and anatomy, and/or functional morphology, who demonstrates the ability and desire to teach Human Anatomy and Physiology courses. Teaching responsibilities may also include general education and introductory survey, or graduate courses or upper division courses in the candidate's specialty. The ideal candidate will be committed to teaching, mentoring, and advising a highly diverse student population. Although teaching is the primary emphasis of this position, other duties include establishing an active research program, advising students on academic and career matters, and involvement in committee and service to the university. This position is contingent upon the availability of authorized funding.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:** The successful candidates are expected to have completed the appropriate terminal degree (Ph.D. or equivalent) with an appropriate academic program.

**PREFERRED QUALIFICATIONS:** Prior successful teaching experience at the college level and post-doctoral experience preferred.
