Ten temporary hourly-intermittent positions available on or after August 17, 2018 and ending on or before May 30, 2019 for the Art department. Hours are flexible and typically range from 2 to 10 hours per weeks. Work hours vary from early morning to evening. Possibility of rehire based on performance, department needs, and budget.

DUTIES: This position will perform duties to include, but not limited to:

- Serve complete modeling session as required by faculty member.
- Modeling is done primarily undraped (nude) in a professional and caring environment.
- Modeling sessions take place in an art studio/class setting with 18 to 24 students.
- Paints, paint solvents, clay and other art materials will be in use during modeling sessions.
- Perform other duties or projects as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Undergraduate students must be registered/enrolled in a minimum of six (6) Fall/Spring units.
- Post-baccalaureate students must be registered in a minimum of four (4) Fall/Spring units in a graduate program.
