I commend you and your department colleagues for your obvious dedication to students and their academic and career success. I appreciated having the opportunity to learn more about the program and your aspirations for the future in the self-study report written by Dr. Susan Mokhtari. It was especially helpful for me to learn more about the need for research-grade equipment (e.g., spectrometer) and challenges students have getting the courses (i.e., Calculus and Chemistry) they need to progress in a timely manner in the program.
