Candidates who possess a valid California Teaching Credential must demonstrate that they have experience teaching in the primary language of the Bilingual Credential for which they are applying.

In order to meet this requirement, applicants must teach at least 20 hours in the primary language. These lessons may be whole class lessons or small group instruction.

The candidate for the Bilingual Credential must:

- 1) Complete the Log of Bilingual Experience in the Classroom form and
- 2) Attach <u>five lesson plans</u> that correspond to the hours documented in the form. These lesson plans must be <u>written</u> in the <u>primary language</u> of instruction. These lessons must be in at least <u>three different subject areas for Multiple Subject or three different lessons for Single Subject.</u>
- 3) Write and attach a <u>two page</u> reflection (12 point font) of what (s)he learned about teaching English learners when using the primary language for instruction. The essay should answer three questions: 1) What did I learn about how best to teach Engish learners? 2) What did I learn about my abilities to teach in a language other than English? And 3) What do I still need to learn (or improve) in order to become an effective teacher of English learner?
