- ✓ Students ready to begin their student teaching/fieldwork experience.
- ✓ MSCP and ESCP Employed students (**including Intern, Short-Term Staff Permit, etc.**)
- ✓ Single Subject students who are ready to begin student teaching 1st semester.

Eligibility Requirements for Student Teaching/Fieldwork:

- STUDENT TEACHING APPLICATION:** You **must complete and submit** a student teaching application **no later than Friday, November 1, 2019** for student teaching consideration. *This applies to long-term or intern teaching for MSCP & ESCP only.*
*Previous applications will not be considered.
- MANDATORY ORIENTATION:** You **must attend one** of the following orientations for your program. **If you do not attend an orientation, you WILL NOT receive a placement.**

- CSET'S OR SUBJECT MATTER WAIVERS:** You **must pass and submit** all CSET results in your content area **no later than Friday, November 15, 2019** to be eligible to student teach spring 2020.
Single Subject Students may turn in a "Course Verification Form" with this application to show that work in progress courses will be passed by the end of the semester. This form can be found online at: www.csustan.edu/teacher-education/student-teaching/secondary-education
- RICA (MSCP & ESCP Only):** You **must take** the RICA exam **on or before Sunday, December 29, 2019** to be eligible for student teaching. If you do not select Stanislaus to receive your results electronically, you will need to submit proof that you took the exam. *It is required that you take RICA by the deadline to student teach. You do not necessarily need to pass; however, Field Services requires results released by Wednesday, January 8, 2020. RICA is not required for Single Subject students.*
- COMPLETED COURSES:** You **must obtain clearance** to begin your student teaching. All courses and/or admission requirements are to be completed or currently in progress, to be eligible to student teach spring 2020.
 - ❖ **NOTE:** Multiple Subject and Education Specialist students may take up to 3 units in addition to student teaching (except for EDMS 4110 or EDMS 4121). *A Selection & Review Petition form is required for approval to take additional units.*
