Contextual Factors in Understanding Fall 2020 Admission Patterns:

1. Maintained May 1, 2020 deadline for admitted students to declare their intent to enroll.
2. Even with 328 fewer freshmen, the campus will still be 7% over the current enrollment target in Fall 2020.
3. Stan State is not launching new recruitment initiatives, but will work on reducing summer melt among the 1,475 freshmen who have confirmed their intent to enroll.
