The Student Transfer Achievement Reform Act of 2021 streamlines the process by which California community college students may transfer to a four-year university. In the AVP meeting today, Vice Chancellor discussed this topic. There will be some changes to general education. Most discussions revolve around Area A1 and Area E. UC does not have Area A1. The committee will announce their proposal in May. President Junn did

not sign the campus resolution. The resolution will be with Academic Senate again as a Sense of the Senate.
