1. Set up your student center and email



- a. [Login information](#) will be sent to your email 2-3 weeks after submitting your application.
 - b. Stan State email and student center will be our primary means of communication. Check often!
 - c. You can view the current status of your admissions application in your [myStanState student center](#).

2. Becoming a Warrior link



- a. The Becoming a Warrior link becomes available on February 1 for admitted students. "Becoming a Warrior" will show you the steps you need to complete to ensure a smooth transition to Stanislaus State.
 - b. Link becomes available in your student center "To Do" list 24 hours after your first log in.

3. Transfer Steps to Enrollment



- **April 1:** Submit official transcripts (if requested).

- **May 1*:** Accept Admissions & Pay \$100 enrollment deposit.
 - [Enrollment Deposit Fee Waiver](#) (optional) submit by 4/26/21
 - [View our FAQ](#).
- **June 4*:** Register and pay for [New Student Orientation](#) (NSO) -\$75 fee.

- **June 30*:** Submit [final official transcripts](#) (if requested).

Missing any of the deadlines marked "*" will result in your application being cancelled.

4. Financial aid and scholarships 2021-2022



- a. Submit new 2021-2022 financial aid application: October 1, 2020 - March 2, 2021

-Add California State University, Stanislaus to your list of Colleges-Federal School Code: 001157
- b. Submit additional documents to Financial Aid & Scholarship Office (if requested). Check to do list.
- c. 2021/2022 [Stan State scholarship application](#) available: November 1, 2020 - March 2, 2021.
- d. Have financial aid questions? [Request a virtual meeting](#) with a financial aid advisor.

5. Associate Degree for Transfer Verification



- a. If you are earning an AA-T/AS-T the university needs to verify your degree via official transcripts or AD-T Verification form. Ask your WOW Admissions Counselor if you need assistance with this step.
- b. No longer completing an AS-T/AA-T? This will not affect you admissions to Stan State as long as you complete the admissions requirements by the end of Summer 21 term.

6. Complete Health Screening



Entering CSU students are required to present proof of immunizations before beginning their first term of enrollment. Visit the Health Center website for information on how to meet this requirement.

7. Appeals



If your admissions application gets denied or cancelled, you have the option to submit an appeal. Submit appeal within two weeks from the date of admissions notification.

- Request re-evaluation of denied admissions appeal

8. Attend New Student Orientation (NSO)



NSO will provide you with important information about University requirements, general education requirements and student programs and services. During NSO you will be getting major academic advising and registering for Fall 21 semester!
