### Community College

- Complete CSU General Ed transfer requirements (minimum of 60 transferable semester units)
- ◆ Complete Stan State Credential Program prerequisite requirements:
  - -American Government:

-Child Development Multiple Subject Credential Program (K-8)

-Human Development Adolescence Single Subject Credential Program (7-12) MJC: PSYCH 141

MJC: PSYCH 141 Delta College: CDEV 021 Merced College: CLDV 09 or PSYCH 09

-Second Language experience, 3 units required for students who have not completed one year of a second language in high school.

#### Stanislaus State

- Earn a Bachelor's Degree within your major
- ◆ Complete Credential Program Prerequisite requirements:
  - -Basic Skills Requirement
  - -Subject Matter Competency (CSET or Approved Subject Matter Prep Program- SMPP)
  - -Minimum of 45 hours of observation (early field experience in teaching)
  - -EDSS 3900: Foundations of Secondary Ed (Single Subject only)
