

POSITION: Standardized Patient Actor

JOB NUMBER: SA-5068

Sixty temporary hourly-intermittent positions available on or after September 5, 2018 and ending on or before May 30, 2019 for the Nursing Departments Standardized Patient (SP) Program. The incumbent will be recorded for teaching, assessment, and research purposes. Possibility of rehire based on performance, department needs, and budget.

DUTIES: This position will perform duties to include, but not limited to:

- Assist with simulating a patient case, responding to emails promptly, demonstrating professional behavior and accountability for actions; as well as, working as a member of a team and maintaining commitments to the Standardized Patient (SP) Program.
- Attend scheduled workshops and training sessions, as requested.
- Assist by simulating all aspects of the patient scenario, including history of current problem, affect/behavior and physical findings in a standardized, accurate, and reliable manner. (A faculty member will provide details of the roles to be performed and supporting objectives of the simulation which will be recorded for teaching, assessment, and research purposes.)
- Assists faculty-driven debriefing sessions by providing verbal feedback to learners.
- Monitor other standardized patients for quality assurance.
- Accept ongoing feedback from supervisor and incorporate into the case simulation. Perform all other duties or projects as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Undergraduate students must be registered/enrolled in a minimum of six (6) Fall/Spring units.
- Post-baccalaureate students must be registered in a minimum of four (4) Fall/Spring units in a graduate program.
- Must meet all other eligibility requirements per the Student Employment Policies (see <https://www.csustan.edu/hr/student-employment>).
- Demonstrate the ability to communicate clearly and effectively with a variety of people.
- Demonstrate the ability to recall an encounter accurately for the completion of checklists and written materials during practice sessions and assessments.
- Demonstrate the ability to be well organized in all aspects of work.
- Demonstrate the ability to work effectively as part of a team or independently with a variety of people.
- Demonstrate a lack of biases towards the healthcare system.
- Demonstrate punctuality and reliability in attendance with the ability to provide advance notice in the event of cancellation.
- Demonstrate the capacity of adapting to different work situations.
- Demonstrate comfort with their own body for non-invasive examinations by health personnel.
- Demonstrate access to a computer for email communication, document review, and other aspects for SP coordination.
